3 Ways to Simplify Cycle Counting



Cycle counting helps on two fronts: uncovering mistakes made in the warehouse and maintaining accurate inventory for the picking operation.




#1 - Count by Aisle

- When item locations are dynamic, the likelihood of an item being taken from or placed in the wrong bin increases.
- Counting by aisle can effectively find and correct the most common inventory mistakes made in the warehouse.

#2 - Count Fast-Moving Areas More Often

- The more often inventory is touched or a location is visited, the greater the opportunity for a mistake to be made.
- Counting these areas more often can offset handling mistakes and ensure the picking operation remains efficient.





#3 - Regularly Verify Empty Bins are Empty

- Sometimes pallet contents can be placed into a bin other than what was entered.
- A quick way to find missing inventory is to verify that the bins that NAV thinks are empty are actually empty.
